Day 1 February 7, Wednesday: Depart USA

Very early this morning, we will meet at St. Frances Cabrini Parish (time to be advised) for a group transfer, by coach, to Chicago O'Hare International Airport. Upon arrival, check in at United Airlines for our pilgrimage to the Holy Land. Connect at Newark Liberty Airport for our continuing overnight flight to Tel Aviv. Complimentary meals and beverages will be served aloft. (D,B)

Day 2 February 8, Thursday: Arrive in the Land of the Bible | Jaffa | Caesarea Maritima | Netanya on the Mediterranean Sea

Arrive at Ben Gurion Tel Aviv Airport, go through Passport Control, claim our luggage, and a Peter's Way tour manager/guide will meet us upon our exit from Customs. Board your comfortable touring bus and soon, we will be on our way to the old port of Joppa (Jaffa) for a visit. It was from Joppa that Jonah embarked on his ill-fated voyage to Tarshish. Also in Joppa, Peter had his vision in the house of Simon the tanner. **Celebrate Mass at St. Peter's Church.** After Mass, we will stop for lunch, then continue to Caesarea by the Sea, site of a flourishing early Christian community, where the ruins of Turkish, Crusader and Roman Civilizations are still visible. Biblically, St. Paul was imprisoned here before being sent to Rome for trial. It was here also that St. Peter baptized the first Gentiles. Visit includes the Theatre, newly excavated Palace, Hippodrome and the Harbor. Our first night will be in Netanya, located on the beautiful Mediterranean Sea. Check-in at hotel upon arrival in Netanya. Dinner and overnight at hotel in Netanya. (D)

Day 3 February 9, Friday: Mt. Carmel | Nazareth | Cana | Sea of Galilee

Buffet breakfast at hotel. After breakfast, begin our day with a visit to Mt. Carmel (Vineyard of God) on the Mediterranean coast. Visit Stella Maris Monastery and Elijah's Cave. We will also visit Keren-Carmel, a hill on the southeastern side of Mount Carmel. On the hill is a small Carmelite order church named after Elijah and the site of his victory over the Baal prophets. Continue to Nazareth for independent lunch. After lunch, we will explore Nazareth, the village in which Jesus grew up and lived most of his life. **Celebrate Mass at the Basilica of the Annunciation or the Church of St. Joseph.** After Mass, visit Joseph's workshop and the Church of the Old Synagogue, which marks the beginning of Jesus' public ministry. As we depart Nazareth, we will make a stop at Mt. Precipice. The hilltop provides sweeping views of the Jezreel Valley, Mt. Tabor and other sites in Galilee. Proceed to Cana, where Jesus performed His first miracle. Visit the Wedding Church, built in the nineteenth century over ruins from Jesus' time. See the display of stone jars and reflect on the miracle of the changing of water into wine. Continue on to the Sea of Galilee, for hotel check-in. Dinner and overnight at hotel by the Sea of Galilee. (B,D)

Day 4 February 10, Saturday: Sea of Galilee | Capernaum | Magdala

Breakfast at hotel. After breakfast, begin our day with a boat ride on the Sea of Galilee. The Gospels come to life as we imagine when Jesus walked on the water (John 6:19-21), calmed a storm (Matt. 8:23-26), and showed the disciples miraculous catches of fish (Luke 5:1-8; John 21:1-6). Arrive at Capernaum, an ancient fishing village on the north shore of the Sea of Galilee where Jesus started His ministry. It was here that Jesus called Matthew to discipleship. Jesus worked many of His miracles in Capernaum. Here, the 2nd century synagogue undoubtedly enclosed the sacred sanctuary in which Jesus taught and preached. Most Scripture scholars recognize the home of Peter's mother-in-law in the remains of a church near the shore as dedicated to his honor. **Celebrate Mass in the Church of Capernaum founded on the traditional site of St. Peter's home.** Continue to Tabgha, an area near Capernaum known in ancient times as Heptapegon - "Place of the Seven Springs." This area near the shore is associated with the miracle of the loaves and fishes during Jesus' Galilean ministry. Visit the Church of the Multiplication and the Church of the Primacy of Peter, built on the traditional site where Jesus told Peter to "Feed my sheep" after the miraculous catch of fish and breakfast on the shore. Independent lunch. Continue to the Mount of Beatitudes to visit the octagonal church commemorating the Sermon on the Mount. This afternoon we will visit Migdal, the hometown of Mary Magdalene, to explore the wonderful excavation discovered by the Legionaries of Christ. Dinner and overnight at hotel by the Sea of Galilee. (B,D)

Day 5 February 11, Sunday: Mt. Tabor | Jordan Valley | Jericho | Jerusalem

Breakfast at hotel. Today's bus journey is filled with variety and excitement. Leave the Sea of Galilee and drive to Mt. Tabor. At the foot of Mt. Tabor take taxis to the top of the mountain. The elevation provides an utterly commanding view of Galilee. **Celebrate Mass at the Church of the Transfiguration.** Then, continue along the Jordan Valley. You will marvel at the desert that is blooming with beautiful flowers, fruits and vegetables. Early afternoon arrive in Jericho for independent lunch. As we depart Jericho, we will see a centuries-old sycamore tree in the center of the city, and recall the incident in which the tax collector Zacchaeus, too short to see over the crowd, climbed a sycamore's branches in order to see Jesus. On our way to Jerusalem we will stop in Bethany, where Martha, Mary and Lazarus welcomed Jesus in their home. Visit the Church of St. Lazarus and the traditional tomb of Lazarus. Continue "Up to Jerusalem" and check-in at the hotel upon arrival. Dinner and overnight at hotel in Jerusalem. (B,D)

Day 6 February 12, Monday: Bethlehem | Shepherds' Fields | Ein Karem

Breakfast at hotel. Begin our day with a drive to the hills of Bethlehem where you can read the biblical account of Ruth, David and the birth of Jesus. Upon arrival we will visit Shepherds' Fields, where you will see some of the caves, which are typical of the stables in the time of Jesus' Birth. The highlight of our time in Bethlehem will be a visit to the traditional birthplace of Jesus, in the Basilica of the Nativity. Here, the Prince of Peace was born! Venerate the silver star that marks the place where the sublime mystery of the Incarnation was revealed in a manger! Let us kneel down and lift our hearts and voices in song, as we imagine that holy "Silent Night." Nearby we visit the Milk Grotto, the site according to tradition where the Blessed Mother and St. Joseph sought shelter after the Birth of Our Lord. Free time will be given for independent lunch and shopping in Manger Square. This afternoon we will visit Ein Karem, hometown of Elizabeth and Zachariah and birthplace of St. John the Baptist. Walk uphill to the Church of the Visitation and imagine Mary's journey through the hill country to see her cousin Elizabeth. **Celebrate Mass at the Church of the Visitation.** After Mass, time will be given for prayer and reflection as we read verses from the Magnificat engraved on the columns of the church, and opposite wall. We will also visit the Church of St. John the Baptist, which honors the birthplace of St. John. Dinner and overnight at hotel in Jerusalem. (B,D)

Day 7 February 13, Tuesday: Mount of Olives | Gethsemane | Mt. Zion | New City

Breakfast at hotel. This morning we will drive to the top of Mount of Olives. The summit offers a magnificent view of the Old City of Jerusalem. Then, follow Jesus' Palm Sunday route along Hosanna Road. Pause to visit and **celebrate Mass in the Chapel of Dominus Fleuit (The Lord Wept).** Continue to the Garden of Gethsemane. Visit the Church of All Nations to pray at the "Rock of Agony," a section of bedrock identified as the place where Jesus prayed alone in the garden on the night of His arrest. Then, visit the Church of St. Peter-in-Gallicantu, built on the site of the Palace of Caiaphas, where Jesus was imprisoned and Peter denied the Lord three times. Continue to the Upper Room, memorial site of the Last Supper and descent of the Holy Spirit upon the Apostles. Our last visit this morning will be made to Dormition Abbey, built to honor the Assumption of Our Lady. Independent lunch. After lunch, we will visit the Israeli Museum to explore an enlightening model of the city of Jerusalem as it was in the days of Jesus. **Evening option: Return to the Garden of Gethsemane for a Eucharistic Holy Hour.** Dinner and overnight at hotel in Jerusalem. (B,D)

Day 8 February 14, Ash Wednesday: Wilderness of Judea | Mount of Temptation | Jericho | Dead Sea

Breakfast at hotel. After breakfast, we will go into the wilderness, to the Jordan River, where Jesus was baptized by John. At the traditional baptismal site we reflect on our need for repentance. Our Lenten journey begins at the Mount of Temptation. We will take a cable car ride to the Mount of Temptation Monastery and reflect on the temptations that Jesus endured for forty days. Then, **celebrate Mass at the Church of the Good Shepherd in Jericho.** Independent lunch in Jericho. We will spend time this afternoon relaxing at the Dead Sea. Enjoy a panoramic view of Ein Gedi, where David hid from Saul's wrath and the locale of the Song of Songs. On our return to Jerusalem, pass by the "Inn of the Good Samaritan." Dinner and overnight at hotel in Jerusalem. (B,D)

Day 9 February 15, Thursday: Via Dolorosa | Emmaus

After breakfast, transfer by coach to Lions' Gate (St. Stephen's Gate), located in the Old City Walls of Jerusalem. Walk to the Crusader Church of St. Anne and explore the Pool of Bethesda. Continue to the Convent of the Sisters of Zion to see the Lithostrotos in the Chapel of the Flagellation. From here we begin the Via Crucis, where Jesus set out, carrying the Cross. Pray the Stations of the Cross along the Via Dolorosa, culminating in the Basilica of the Holy Sepulchre. **Celebrate Mass at the Chapel of the Blessed Sacrament.** Independent lunch in Jerusalem. This afternoon we will visit one of the traditional sites of Emmaus and recall the story in Luke's Gospel where Jesus appeared to His disciples on the road, after the Resurrection. Return to Jerusalem. Dinner and overnight at hotel in Jerusalem. (B,D)

Day 10 February 16, Friday: Old City of Jerusalem & Temple Mount | Free afternoon in Jerusalem

After breakfast, drive to the Garden of Gethsemane to **celebrate Mass at the Altar above the Rock of Agony.** After breakfast, explore the Old City, the Temple Mount and Western Wall. Above the Temple foundations, we view the El Aksa Mosque and the Dome of the Rock. Visit the excavation of the Western Wall (Ophel Hill). Here, we might also reflect on the journey of Mary and Joseph as they carried Jesus up these steps to Present Him in the Temple after His birth. Walking through the narrow alleyways and streets of Jerusalem seeing the Pinnacle of the Temple (Gate of Hulda - after Pentecost, it was here where the disciples preached and baptized). We will also visit the newly constructed Jewish Quarter "Cardo." Independent lunch and free afternoon in Jerusalem. Our guide will accompany those who wish to participate in an optional afternoon visit to Masada. Return to Jerusalem for group farewell dinner at the Ambassador hotel. Following dinner, freshen-up before our evening transfer to Tel Aviv Airport for our return flight to the USA. Overnight on your non-stop flight to the USA. (B,D)

Day 11 February 17, Saturday: Return to the USA

Early morning, arrive in Newark Liberty Airport, and connect to Chicago O'Hare Airport. Late morning, arrive in Chicago filled with memories that will change your life. (B,D)

PAYMENT: Deposits and insurance payments will be accepted in the form of check, money order or credit card. The package pricing reflects a discount of \$100.00 per person for payments made entirely by personal check, money order or certified bank check. The package price is \$100 higher if paid by credit card. If final payment is not received by the balance deadline, Peter's Way Tours reserves the right to cancel your reservation. If for any reason payment is received within 21 days of departure, a charge for express mailing of final documents will apply. A \$50.00 late payment fee and possible increase in airfare may apply for late payments. Personal checks will not be accepted within 30 days of departure. If the bank has returned a personal check, a \$25.00 processing fee will apply and subsequent payments must be made in the form of money order, certified bank check or credit card.

CANCELLATIONS/REFUNDS: From the time your deposit is received up to 130 days prior to departure, there is a \$250.00 nonrefundable cancellation fee per person. From 129 to 100 days prior to departure, there is a \$350.00 nonrefundable cancellation fee per person. From 99 days prior to departure up to the day of departure, there is a nonrefundable cancellation fee of 100% of all payments made per person including departure taxes & fuel surcharges, single supplement, deviation fees, travel insurance payments and any other costs incurred. Travel insurance is offered as protection for cancellations due to medical reasons such as illness or injury, please see TRAVEL INSURANCE. Travel insurance payments are nonrefundable upon receipt. Tour participation is nontransferable. Names cannot be transferred on reservations or airline tickets. Refund requests can only be honored when submitted in writing to Peter's Way Tours. All refund requests are subject to cancellation restrictions as set forth above. No refund will be made for any accommodations or services included in the tour that you do not use.

LATE RESERVATIONS: A \$25.00 late fee and possible increase in airfare may apply for bookings received after the deposit deadline. All space is subject to availability and cannot be guaranteed past the deposit deadline noted on the brochure.

TRAVEL DOCUMENTS: All participants must have a valid passport. **U.S. Passports must be valid for at least six (6) months, subsequent to return date.** Special entry requirements for non-U.S. citizens may apply. Please consult the appropriate Consulate for current requirements. It is solely the passenger's responsibility to ensure that all documents needed are completed and current. Peter's Way Tours will not be held responsible for lack of current and valid entry documents.

AIR TRANSPORTATION: Tentative round trip from **Chicago on United Airlines.** Flight itinerary and carrier may be subject to change. Departure taxes & fuel surcharges are estimated. They are determined solely by the airlines and are subject to increase prior to ticketing (*approximately 30 days prior to departure*).

AIRLINE SEATING: Under group airline reservations/contracts, the airlines will provide a block of seats for the group. Individual requests for seating preferences can only be made at time of check-in. Peter's Way cannot submit seating preferences as we cannot guarantee that any or all requests will be honored. If you require specific seating as a condition of your travel, it is suggested that you book your airfare individually and purchase the Land Only package. Upgrades to premium economy, business class, or first class may be available but oftentimes airlines will not allow the upgrades until time of ticketing (*approximately 30 days prior to departure*). Group reservations may not be accessible online for advance check-in/boarding passes/seat assignments. Airline guidelines vary. Please contact our office for specific details.

LAND ONLY PASSENGERS: Land Only packages do not include any portion of the group airfare. This includes any flights booked within the group itinerary. All airline tickets will be your responsibility to book independently. A passenger choosing the Land Only portion of the package (**pricing will be confirmed by March 25, 2017**) must notify Peter's Way Tours, in writing, at least 100 days prior to departure or a penalty fee will be assessed. Please be advised, passenger(s) opting for the Land Only package or who are deviating from the group itinerary will be responsible for their own transfers to/from hotel/airport. However, if you arrive at the same time or earlier than your group, you are welcome to join the group on the bus. It is recommended that you purchase your air transportation only after you have been notified that the group has materialized. If you purchase your own air transportation and the group does not materialize or you cancel your package for any reason, Peter's Way Tours will not be held responsible for the cost of your airfare or other arrangements booked independently.

DEVIATIONS & ITINERARY CHANGES: Peter's Way Tours is pleased to assist clients with changes in itineraries. All deviation requests must be submitted in writing at least 90 days prior to departure. Deviation fee will apply plus an airline change fee per person. Your routing and dates requested will determine if a difference in airfare will also apply. Not all carriers permit routing changes and/or deviations from the group itinerary. Please contact our office for detailed information.

TRANSFERS AND PORTERAGE: Round-trip airport transfers are included for passengers who purchase the full air and land package. Porterage of one piece of luggage throughout your tour at hotels is also included.

ACCOMMODATIONS/SINGLE TRAVELERS: Price per person is based on two persons sharing twin bedded rooms with private facilities in hotels throughout your tour. Double bedded rooms for married couples are subject to availability and must be requested. Triple rooms may be available for family or friends traveling together. We discourage triple room accommodations because they are usually not spacious and there is no discount for triple occupancy. Triple rooms usually are regular twin or double bedded rooms with a rollaway bed added. Single rooms are limited but may be requested at booking for an **additional charge of \$650.00**. While single rooms provide privacy, they are often smaller than twin bedded rooms and may be away from the group in hotels. We will make every effort (if you so desire) to match you with a same gender roommate when we receive your application, but we do not guarantee a roommate can be matched. If a single room must be assigned due to your roommate's cancellation, incompatibility or for any other reason (even at the last

moment or on tour), we must charge the tour's single supplement or pro-rated amount.

MEALS: Buffet breakfast and dinner daily, including farewell dinner prior to departure from Tel Aviv on February 16th. Beverages (coffee, tea, mineral water) are not included at set menu dinners.

GRATUITIES & SERVICE CHARGES: Gratuities are not included in your tour package. Although voluntary, for good work, we recommend \$7.00 per person per day for your tour manager; \$3.00 per person per day for your bus driver. Tips for your tour manager and bus driver are normally given as a group at the end of the tour. All service charges and local taxes as imposed by hotels are included in the program rate. Although service charges are included, it is customary to leave \$1.00 per person for the waiters after each meal and \$1.00 per person per day for the maid/bell boys.

TRAVELER HEALTH ADVISORY: All passengers must ensure that they are medically and physically fit for travel; and that such traveling will not endanger themselves or others as our pilgrimages entail a lot of walking, which may involve stairs, hills, cobblestone roads and uneven pavement. Additionally, most motor coaches are not equipped with wheelchair ramps. It is each passenger's responsibility to be aware of his or her limits with regard to travel and group activities. Any person with a disability requiring special attention must advise Peter's Way Tours of the situation at time of enrollment. A qualified companion must accompany any passenger requiring special assistance.
