

Wisconsin Catholic Heritage Tour and Pilgrimage to the Shrine of Our Lady of Good Help August 21-22, 2018



Tentative Itinerary

Sponsored by Saint Frances Cabrini and Saint Mary's Immaculate Conception Parishes

Join Father Nathan Reesman, Father Andrew Infanger and Seminarian Stephen Buting on a unique journey to experience some of the Catholic history of Wisconsin, and to make a pilgrimage to the Shrine of Our Lady of Good Help. We will experience Catholic Wisconsin in the beauty of its past, in its rich ethnic heritage, and also in the evangelical vibrancy of its present and future. Come experience the Church alive across the ages. Persons from all parishes are welcome to join.



Day 1: Tuesday, August 21, 2018

We will load the bus at 7:00am and plan to depart from Saint Frances Cabrini lower parking lot at 7:15am. We will arrive at Saint Lawrence Catholic Church, built by Czech immigrants for our first stop. While at the church we will celebrate Mass and have a tour of the historic church. Here we will learn of the great miracle that took place in 1862 that precipitated Saint Lawrence Church being built! For lunch we will be treated to Sonny's Pizzeria of Luxemburg. After lunch we will head to the Green Bay Cathedral. This beautiful building contains Romanesque architecture modeled from the Ludwigkirche in Munich, Germany where then Monsignor Krautbauer was pastor before immigrating to the United States. Bishop Krautbauer is interred under a granite slab in the floor at the Bishop Wycislo entrance. Finally, we will head to our hotel in Green Bay for check-in. After settling into our rooms, all are invited for a wine and cheese social hour in the hotel lobby. We will conclude our evening with dinner at Hagemeister Park. Time after dinner will be available for those who wish to explore the boardwalk area around Green Bay. (L,D)

Day 2: Wednesday, August 22, 2018

We begin our day with breakfast at the hotel. Our first stop for the day will be at The National Shrine of Our Lady of Good Help where we will celebrate Mass. This is the only approved apparition site of the Blessed Virgin Mary in the United States. Afterwards, we will have time to explore the Shrine, visit the new museum, and pray the Stations of the Cross. Confessions are also available at the Shrine starting at 10am. We will depart the Shrine and head to Mackinaw in Green Bay for lunch. After lunch, we will head back to Denmark to explore the Curran Spirituality Center. This devotional prayer chapel was newly established in 2016. We will learn from the priest who founded the Center why such a place is necessary in our changing world. We will conclude our Wisconsin Heritage Pilgrimage by visiting the Krohn Dairy Store and Agropur Cheese Factory. Pilgrims will be able to purchase cheese and other goodies, we will provide coolers for the bus. We anticipate a 6pm return. (B, L)

Purchaser and/or traveler of this pilgrimage (you) acknowledges that Saint Frances Cabrini is acting as an independent intermediary (travel agent) between you and suppliers of goods and services, which are not directly supplied by Saint Frances Cabrini, such as hotel accommodations, ground transportations, tour guides, etc. and shall not be responsible for actions or omissions on the part of such suppliers, which may result in any loss, damage, delay or injury to you or your travel companions or group members.

Saint Frances Cabrini contracting its service shall not be responsible for any injuries, damages or losses caused to any traveler in connection with social or labor unrest, mechanical or construction difficulties, diseases, local laws, climatic conditions, war, terrorist activities or any other actions, omissions, or conditions outside of their control.

By embarking upon his/her travel, the traveler(s) voluntarily assumes all the risks. Your booking shall constitute a consent to the above and engaging the company, acknowledges these conditions and agrees to hold the company blameless in making the arrangements on his/her behalf, and agrees that restitution or damages, if any are claimed, shall be sought directly from the suppliers.

Payments: For short motor-coach pilgrimage, full payment is required to secure your space. Make your check payable to Saint Frances Cabrini. *Payments will be refunded in the event the pilgrimage does not meet the minimum quorum necessary to make the trip possible.*

Pilgrimage Participation: To ensure a positive experience, Saint Frances Cabrini reserves the right to reject any individual whose conduct is incompatible with the interest of the group. Saint Frances Cabrini is not responsible for lost persons and for the expenses incurred while being lost. Each traveler assumes responsibility for staying with the group.

Cancellations: All cancellations must be received in writing to Saint Frances Cabrini prior to July 23, 2018. After July 23, 2018 no refunds will be available. Reservations are transferable, so we will work with you to fill your spot. If another person is not able to take your spot, no refunds can be given after July 23, 2018.

Travelers with Special Needs: Passengers who require attention must advise the pilgrimage operator at the time of booking. Coaches are not equipped with wheelchair accessible ramps, therefore all pilgrimage members must be able to mount 3 to 5 steps into the coach. **Participants should expect to walk approximately 1 mile per day.** Walking surfaces may at times be uneven.

Motor-coach Transportation and seating: We have selected a reputable and quality motor-coach line for this pilgrimage. Staff reserves the front row for ease with microphone use and driver communications when performing the pilgrimage program. Seat rotation is requested each day so that all passengers get to enjoy different views from the coach.

Young Travelers: Travelers who are less than 18 years old on the departure date must be accompanied by an adult and must share the adult's accommodations.

Not Included: All items of a personal nature (room service, beverages, telephone charges, laundry, etc) and meals not specified on the pilgrimage itinerary are not included and must be paid by the passenger.

Accommodations and Itinerary: Saint Frances Cabrini reserves the right to change or substitute (1) hotels for accommodations in similar categories (2) or features of the itinerary in order to accommodate changes in the schedule.

Meals: Meals are provided as specified in the program. If you require special meals due to dietary restrictions, we must receive written details of your requirements at the time of booking.

Smoking: Smoking is not allowed on the motor-coach but frequent stops are made throughout the day.

Tips: Gratuities are included for the majority of the pilgrimage. Gratuities for Motorcoach Drivers are not included- we recommend \$3 or more per person for the trip. This will be collected on return trip.

Luggage: Only one piece of luggage is allowed per person. No baggage handling is included in this pilgrimage. Luggage is carried at owner's risk throughout the pilgrimage. All baggage and small articles such as coats, umbrellas or cameras are entirely in the care of the passenger. Please bring a carry on size luggage if possible. This will help with space on the bus.

All baggage and personal effects are at all times and in all circumstances at the risk of the passenger.
